Government responds to time zone concerns

IQALUIT, Nunavut (November 4, 2000) – The Government of Nunavut will permit its employees in the communities of Kugluktuk and Cambridge Bay to work on Central Standard Time, in response to concerns raised when Nunavut remained on Central Daylight Saving Time on October 29, 2000.

As a result of this adjustment, Kugluktuk and Cambridge Bay will operate on Central Standard Time during the winter months (October to April), then move their clocks ahead one hour in April, bringing the entire territory into the same time. All other Nunavut communities will leave their clocks unchanged throughout the entire year.

The adjustment becomes effective at midnight on Saturday, November 4, 2000.
