Government of Nunavut and the Nunavut Employees Union set to resume talks in April

IQALUIT, Nunavut (January 25, 2001) – Mediation talks held this week between the Government of Nunavut and the Nunavut Employees Union, a component of the Public Service Alliance of Canada, adjourned yesterday. Talks are scheduled to continue from April 4 to 8.

Both parties, meeting in Iqaluit from January 20 to 24, worked hard towards establishing a first collective agreement. Progress was made but further discussions are required. When negotiations begin again in the spring, it is hoped that a tentative agreement will be reached.
