## Minister Aglukkaq appoints new members to Qulliit

**IQALUIT, Nunavut (December 9, 2005)** – Leona Aglukkaq, Minister Responsible for the Status of Women, today announced the appointment of four members to the Qulliit Nunavut Status of Women Council.

"Each of these new members brings unique experiences to the Council that will only enhance its ability to improve the lives of women across Nunavut," said Aglukkaq.

"These women are dedicated to improving the lives of women in Nunavut," said Aglukkaq. "I extend my best wishes to the newest members of Qulliit and my appreciation to the Council for the good work they do on behalf of Nunavummiut."

Qulliit's mandate is to work for the equality for all women in Nunavut through advice to government, research, public education, and advocacy.
