Premier Tables Tamapta Action Plan in Legislative Assembly

IQALUIT, Nunavut (December 8, 2009) - Premier Eva Aariak was very pleased to table the Tamapta Action Plan yesterday in the Legislative Assembly of Nunavut.

"I am thrilled to table the Tamapta Action Plan. It is a plan that describes not only what we want to achieve, but how we will do it," said Premier Aariak.

The Action Plan was developed after much consultation. Full Caucus met from October 20-23 to discuss the Report Card findings and to add additional suggestions in the context of the Tamapta Vision & Priorities. They met once more last week to review and discuss the updated Action Plan.

"I would like to thank all my colleagues for their comments and input to the draft Action Plan. Working together as a Full Caucus I believe we proved what can be achieved when we work together. We truly captured the essence of "consensus government," said Premier Aariak.

The Tamapta Action Plan outlines specific strategies for each of the priorities of the government. The mandate is focused on improving public service, growth through education, and promoting self-reliance.

"Although this is an important step, it is only the beginning," said Premier Aariak. "This is not only our plan of action, but also our commitment to this territory. We trust that Nunavummiut will follow our progress closely and hold us accountable for achieving what we have set out to do," said Premier Aariak.
