Minister Tapardjuk's resignation is effective at the close of the fall sitting of the Legislative Assembly. At that time, Premier Eva Aariak will assume Minister Tapardjuk's portfolios, including Culture, Language, Elders & Youth (CLEY); Languages; and, Minister Responsible for the Utility Rates Review Council.
