An Inuktitut language phone-in program to raise awareness about Nunavut devolution will air on APTN Northern Service, on April 25, 2013, from 8 to 9 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, 7 to 8 p.m. Central Standard Time, 6 to 7 p.m. Mountain Standard Time.

Nunavut was formed in 1999, yet 80% of our territorial lands are still controlled and managed by the federal government.

Devolution will mean that final decisions over Nunavut's public lands and resources will be made in Nunavut by Nunavummiut.
