



Nunavummiut and follow national standards, were developed through a working group consisting of representatives from the GN, NTI, the NWMB and the three regional wildlife organizations. This collaborative approach, along with a series of public hearings held in 2006 and 2007, ensures that the new regulations meet the unique needs of Nunavut.

These new regulations represent the ongoing, concerted efforts to ensure that all Nunavummiut are able to benefit from the territory's rich natural resources.
