## New Wildlife Regulations

On July 1, 2015, the Government of Nunavut Department of Environment is implementing new regulations under the *Wildlife Act*. These regulations were developed in cooperation with the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board and Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated, and are designed to be fully compliant with the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement.

The new regulations make some important changes to the wildlife management system in Nunavut, including new reporting requirements for wildlife related businesses, licence requirements for companies involved in wildlife viewing or filmmaking, and changes in fees for those who require licences.
