Nunavut Parks and Special Places wishes to advise users of the Ittijjagiatq Trail between Iqaluit and Kimmirut in Katannilik Territorial Park that snow conditions are deteriorating.

Due to the warm temperatures and recent rainfall, the trail conditions are wet, slushy and potentially hazardous. The trail conditions continue to deteriorate daily. Users are reminded to travel safely, with the proper safety gear and, if possible, to travel with a companion.
