Food recall on Quaker Harvest, Spitz and CLIF Bar products

June 3, 2016
Iqaluit, NU

The Department of Health is warning about a food recall on Quaker Harvest brand quinoa granola bars, Spitz brand sunflower kernels, and CLIF Bar brand Sierra Trail Mix Energy Bar due to possible contamination with the bacteria *Listeria monocytogenes*.

Listeria symptoms include vomiting, nausea, fever, muscle aches, severe headaches and neck stiffness. Most people do not need to see a health care provider because they get better quickly. But high risk groups, like pregnant women, Elders and people with weakened immune systems, should see a health care provider if they have these symptoms.

All recalled products should be thrown out or returned to the location where they were purchased.
