## Call for proposals – grants and contributions

The Department of Family Services is now accepting funding proposals for 2016-17, for small-scale projects, programs or outreach services that will help in the prevention, reduction and reoccurrence of homelessness in Nunavut.

Non-profit organizations, societies and municipal organizations that provide or intend to provide homelessness supportive services or programs can apply for funding for projects that could include:

- Workshops that build awareness and understanding of the factors that lead to homelessness.
- Workshops that build life skills.
- Initiatives that link individuals experiencing homelessness with opportunities for training, career development or building traditional skills.
- Initiatives that help individuals experiencing homelessness to access support services or employment opportunities.

Applicants must complete the <u>Homelessness Initiatives Application form</u> and should refer to the <u>Homelessness Initiatives Guidelines</u> when completing the application.
