## Label household chemicals and solvents with poison prevention stickers

Help keep children and youth safe from hazardous poisons by clearly labelling dangerous household chemicals and solvents. New poison prevention stickers are available at all community health centres in Nunavut.

You can help stop poisonings by:

- Putting a poison prevention sticker on all potentially harmful products: household cleaning supplies, laundry detergents, gas, propane and camping fuel.
- Taking the time to explain to your children that this sticker means "STOP" and that what's inside may be dangerous.
- Safely storing all poisonous products and keeping them out of reach of children and youth.

Get your free stickers today, and help stop poisonings! Contact your community health centre for more information on poison prevention. If you think someone may be poisoned, it is important they go to the health centre or hospital immediately.
