The Kitikmeot region played a vital role in sharing Inuit oral history, making the discoveries of the HMS Erebus and the HMS Terror possible. It has helped solve an international mystery, which is now going to be recorded in history.

I look forward to the continued partnership between Nunavut and the Government of Canada as we move into the next phase of celebrating this discovery."
