Applicants should have knowledge and experience in restorative justice, and in dealing with social issues. They should also have knowledge of Inuit societal values, and should be sensitive to helping victims and offenders.

Training with respect to members' roles and responsibilities will be provided. Committee members are volunteer positions, and receive honoraria for attending meetings.
