All Government of Nunavut (GN) offices are closed from December 22, 2017, to January 1, 2018. During this holiday closure period, the following services will be available:

Community and Government Services

Nunavut Emergency Management services will be available for emergencies 24 hours a day, toll free at 1-800-693-1666.

Family Services

Emergency coverage involving child welfare matters will be provided. Contact information for all community social services workers is available at: https://gov.nu.ca/sites/default/files/Social-Services-Offices.pdf.

Finance

Liquor permits will still be available for purchase at the Cambridge Bay and Kugluktuk offices. Please check with them for holiday business hours. Licensee and community orders will not be processed from the Iqaluit and Rankin Inlet warehouses, and no import permits will be issued at the Iqaluit and Rankin Inlet permit offices during the holiday closure period.

Business hours will be reduced at the Iqaluit beer and wine store. On December 22, 23, 27, 28, 29 and 30, the store will be opened from 1-6 p.m. Please note that the store will be closed on Boxing Day, December 26.

Health
