## Occupational trades title changes

Start Date: February 22, 2017 End Date: March 31, 2017

Nunavut-wide 60 sec

Six trades within the *Trade Designation Order* have changed trade titles. The changes help modernize these trades to allow specialization and/or to shorten the completion time without jeopardizing certification standards.

Journeypersons in Nunavut who have been issued certificates with the previous trade titles will keep their current valid certificates. Nunavut-certified journeypersons who wish to request a new certificate with the updated trade title may contact their local career development officer.
