All Government of Nunavut (GN) offices are closed from December 24, 2018, to January 1, 2019. During this holiday closure period, the following services will be available:

Community and Government Services (CGS)

The following CGS divisions will be available for emergencies 24 hours a day:

Environment

To report any spills, please call the 24-hour Spill Report Line at 867-920-8130. To report wildlife issues (polar bear sightings, fox in communities, etc.), please call the emergency call-out line at 867-975-7780.

Family Services

Finance

Liquor permits will be available for purchase at the Cambridge Bay and Kugluktuk offices. Please check with them for holiday business hours. Licensee and community orders will not be processed from the Igaluit and Rankin Inlet warehouses,



and no import permits will be issued at the Iqaluit and Rankin Inlet permit offices during the holiday closure period.

Business hours will be reduced at the Iqaluit beer and wine store. On December 27, 28 and 29, the store will be opened from 1 to 6 p.m., and on December 31, from 12 to 4 p.m. Please note that the store will be closed on December 25, 26 and January 1, 2019.

Health
