Public consultation on cannabis legalization

The Government of Nunavut (GN) is holding public meetings in several communities in January and February to get feedback from Nunavummiut on the proposed regulatory options for legalized recreational cannabis.

- Kugluktuk, on February 9, 6-9 p.m., at the community hall
- Iqaluit, on February 13, 6-9 p.m., at the Anglican parish hall
- Cape Dorset, on February 14, 6-9 p.m., at the community hall
- Kimmirut, on February 15, 6-9 p.m., at the community hall
- Igloolik, on February 20, 6-9 p.m., at the community hall
- Arctic Bay, on February 21, 6-9 p.m., at the community hall
