Food Recalls due to Salmonella

September 7, 2018 Iqaluit, NU

The Department of Health is warning about a food recall issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to possible Salmonella contamination on the following product:

Compliments Brand Chili Powder – The 155 g product has been recalled. The product code is 2020 MA 26 and the UPC number is 0 55742 35921 3. More information on this product recall can be found on the CFIA website at https://bit.ly/2wKoOCy.

This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.

Food contaminated with *Salmonella* may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Short-term symptoms can include fever, headache, vomiting, nausea, abdominal cramps and diarrhea. Young children, pregnant women, Elders and people with weakened immune systems may contract serious and sometimes deadly infections. If you think you became sick from consuming a recalled product, call your local health centre.
