## **Call for nomination Interim Management Advisory Board, RCMP**

Are you interested in the administration and management of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP)? Do you have experience and knowledge managing resources, operating budgets, and providing advice?

The Governor in Council (GIC) has been appointed by the Governor General to select members for the RCMP Interim Management Advisory Board. The GIC will be assisted by the Government of Nunavut Department of Justice, to seek members for this board. This Board will be responsible for providing advice and recommending strategies to the RCMP Commissioner, on the administration and management of the RCMP.

Applicants must be either a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident.

The following Individuals are not eligible to apply for Board membership:

- a) current employees of the RCMP;
- b) members of the Senate, House of Commons, a provincial or territorial legislature of municipal government council;
- c) serving in another GIC role; or
- d) employed on a full-time basis in the federal public administration or the public service of the province, territory or municipality.

All applicants will be required to pass a security clearance.
