Food recalls due to Salmonella

March 1, 2019

Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is warning about a food recall issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to possible Salmonella contamination on the following products:

Compliments – Chicken Nuggets – Breaded Chicken Cutlettes - Uncooked – The 1.5 kg package has been recalled. The product code on the outer package is 2019 JL 18 and the UPC number is 0 55742 33690 0. More information on this product recall can be found on the CFIA website [here](#).

This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.

Food contaminated with Salmonella may not look or smell spoiled but can still cause sickness. Short-term symptoms can include fever, headache, vomiting, nausea, abdominal cramps and diarrhea. Young children, pregnant women, Elders and people with weakened immune systems may contract serious and sometimes deadly infections. If you think you became sick from consuming a recalled product, call your local health centre.
