Food recalls due to Salmonella

March 29, 2019

Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is warning about a food recall issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to Salmonella on the following products:

Sofina Foods Inc – Janes Brand Pub Chicken Style Nuggets – The 800g package has been recalled. The product code is DEC 15, 2019 and the UPC number is 0 69299 12490 3. This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.

Food contaminated with *Salmonella* may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Young children, pregnant women, the elderly and people with weakened immune systems may contract serious and sometimes deadly infections. Healthy people may experience short-term symptoms such as fever, headache, vomiting, nausea, abdominal cramps and diarrhea. Long-term complications may include severe arthritis.
