The Department of Justice will be holding community consultations on the *Family Abuse Intervention Act* (FAIA) and Nunavut's family laws, following a recent motion by the Legislative Assembly in support of a violence-free Nunavut.

FAIA exists to assist people in need of protection from family abuse or the threat of family abuse. This act promotes community ownership of problems and empowers the community to confidently work with local resources to address social problems.

Nunavut's Family Laws ensure the needs of Nunavummiut families can be met in an effective, efficient and culturally meaningful manner.
