Food recalls due to Listeria

November 8, 2021

Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is warning about food recalls issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination.

Metro Brands, Carleton and PC Organics are recalling commercially sold **sliced mushrooms products** due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination. Consumers should not consume the recalled products described below.

This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.

Food contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes* bacteria may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Symptoms can include fever, muscle aches, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or constipation, stomach pain, a stiff neck or a bad headache. If you think you became sick from consuming a recalled product, call your local health centre.
