COVID-19 vaccine available to all children six months and older

The Department of Health is announcing the expansion of the COVID-19 vaccine eligibility group to include all children aged six months to four years old.

With COVID-19 vaccines now available for Nunavummiut six months and older, we can work together towards increasing the protection against COVID-19 in our communities.

The vaccine is safe for children, and it helps protect them, their friends and family from severe COVID-19 infection, hospitalization and death. The vaccine for children in this age group is given at a lower dosage than the vaccine for older children.

Please contact your local health centre to make an appointment to get vaccinated. Help us better protect our families and communities by getting up to date with your vaccinations.
