Food recalls due to possible Cronobacter sakazakii and Salmonella

June 22, 2022

Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is warning about food recalls issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to possible *Cronobacter sakazakii* and *Salmonella*.

Shoppers Drug Mart is recalling certain commercially sold **Abbott brand powdered infant formula products** due to possible *Cronobacter sakazakii* and *Salmonella*. Consumers should not consume the recalled products described below.

This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.
