The Government of Nunavut has been working closely with Microsoft to bridge language gaps using the Microsoft Translator tool, and now a new user guide is available through the Department of Culture and Heritage.

The Department of Culture and Heritage and Department of Community and Government Services' Information Management / Information Technology branch collaborated with Microsoft on the guide. It contains user-friendly instructions to help users take full advantage of the Microsoft Translator tool, improving communications in all of Nunavut's official languages.

The guide enables users to email friends and co-workers, browse the internet, create documents and presentations in Inuktitut syllabics, Inuktitut Roman orthography, Inuinnaqtun, English, and French. Users can use these tools to improve their communication at home, work, school, and while they're travelling.
