## 2023 Recommended Nunavut Land Use Plan

June 28, 2023 Nunavut-wide

The Nunavut Planning Commission has completed a monumental task in recommending a Nunavut-wide land use plan for approval. The Government of Nunavut thanks the Nunavut Planning Commission for their hard work in realizing this Recommended Nunavut Land Use Plan.
