Food recalls due to Cronobacter

March 20, 2023 Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is warning about a food recall issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to possible *Cronobacter sakazakii* contamination.

Nestle Good Start is recalling commercially sold **Soothe infant formula** due to possible *Cronobacter sakazakii* contamination. Consumers should not consume the recalled products described below.

This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.

Food contaminated with *Cronobacter* may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Although *Cronobacter* is not commonly linked to human illness, in rare cases it can cause serious or fatal infections. *Cronobacter* can cause rare bloodstream and central nervous system infections and has been associated with severe intestinal infection (necrotizing enterocolitis) and blood poisoning (sepsis), especially in newborns. information on this product recall can be found on the CFIA website here.
