Canadian Radio-Television and Telecommunications Commission's (CRTC) Nunavut Consultations

Access to reliable, affordable, and high-quality telecom services is crucial for the social, economic, and educational development of Nunavut's communities. The Government of Nunavut (GN) recognizes the importance of the Canadian Radio-Television and Telecommunications Commission's (CRTC) ongoing work regarding telecommunications in the region.

The CRTC is conducting a Nunavut-wide community consultation to determine the current state of telecommunications in Nunavut, and is seeking feedback on:

- How can we help to improve services?
- How can we help to reduce prices?
- Should CRTC create a subsidy to make internet services more affordable?
- How can we help to foster competition?
- How can we help to strengthen dialogue between communities and providers?

The GN encourages all Nunavummiut, organizations, and businesses across Nunavut to go to the www.crtc.gc.ca/north to share your experiences and thoughts on how to improve telecommunications services in Northern communities.
