Call for Proposals – Gender-Based Violence Initiative Funding

The Department of Family Services is committed to supporting initiatives that seek to address Gender-Based Violence (GBV) in Nunavut. Under the GBV National Action Plan, we are excited to offer funding opportunities for the next four years to empower community-based efforts, organizations, and projects aimed at GBV prevention, education, awareness, and support.

The Department is currently accepting proposals for the 2023-24 fiscal year.

Projects can be either one-time initiatives or multi-year endeavors, commencing any time after November 15, 2023.

Proposals should demonstrate how proponents will actively:

- Promote gender-based violence prevention and education.
- Aim to transform social norms, attitudes and behaviors contributing to GBV.
- Enhance health, social, economic and justice outcomes of those impacted by GBV.
- Address underlying causes, prevention strategies, mitigation and responses to GBV.

Eligible applicants include community non-profit organizations, municipal corporations and/or individuals associated with an established non-profit organization or municipal corporation.
