The Department of Economic Development and Transportation is accepting applications for the Inuit Tourism Business Mentorship Program. This program supports tourism business owners in Nunavut to leverage their skills, knowledge, and professional capacity to grow their businesses.

The Inuit Tourism Business Mentorship Program offers training for five Inuit tourism business owners and operators in Nunavut. Each mentorship includes up to 10 days of dedicated project time and includes a combination of in-person and virtual sessions. Each mentorship will last four to six months. Four of the five spots are filled, and we are looking for one more participant.

To be eligible, applicants must be Nunavut Inuit and own a tourism business in Nunavut.

The deadline to apply is November 15, 2023.
