Reminder to update medical certificate for Nunavut driver's licence

Start Date: October 24, 2023 End Date: November 14, 2023 Nunavut-wide

The Government of Nunavut reminds all driver's licence holders to update their medical certificates.

Class 1, 2, 3 and 4 (commercial) licence holders are required to renew their medical certificates every five years until the age of 45, every three years until the age of 65 and every year above the age of 65.

Class 5, 6 and 7 (private vehicles and learners) driver's licence holders are required to present a medical certificate at the age of 75, again at 80 and every two years above the age of 80.

The Registrar can request additional medical examination reports.

If you fail to comply, there will be no further driver licensing services provided and your driver's licence will eventually be suspended.
