Lottery Licence Applications

Start Date: September 29, 2023 End Date: October 6, 2023

Nunavut-wide 60 sec

The Consumer Affairs Section administers lottery licensing for non-delegated communities that do not have the authority to issue lottery licenses.

Religious and charitable organizations that wish to apply or reapply for lottery licences are reminded that:

- Lottery application forms must be completed, including:
 - Name of organization, address, charitable status, intended purpose of lottery, how prizes are guaranteed, proposed venue location, age restrictions, type of event or series, prizes, financial estimate, and signatures from signing authorities
- Other applicable forms must accompany lottery application forms such as Mission Statement/List of Executive form and sample house rules.
- To reapply for a licence, financial statement of account forms must be submitted to Consumer Affairs before a new lottery licence application can be processed.
