Mining has created jobs, provided training, and boosted our territory's economy. Today, Nunavut has two gold mines and one iron mine in operation.

Throughout Mining Week, the GN, in partnership with Baffinland, Canada-Nunavut Geoscience Office and the Northwest Territories and Nunavut Chamber of Mines, will host a series of virtual and in-person workshops, activities and competitions. There are activities for all ages, including children, youth, adults, and elders. Grand prizes for competitions include an Apple iPad, AirPods and Samsung Tablets.
