## **Disability Grant available for eligible FANS recipients**

The Department of Education would like to remind Financial Assistance for Nunavut Students (FANS) recipients with a permanent disability to apply for a Disability Grant to help cover the costs of post-secondary education.

The Disability Grant provides a maximum of \$8,000 per year for equipment and services directly related to a student's education.

The grant is available to recipients of the Basic Grant and does not need to be repaid.

To apply for the Disability Grant, submit a completed <u>FANS Disability Assessment</u> <u>Form</u>. Applications must include a copy of a medical or learning ability assessment conducted by a certified medical professional. The assessment should explain how the disability affects one's ability to participate in post-secondary studies.

Students only need to apply for the Disability Grant once per academic year.
