Government of Nunavut services affected by strike at Canada Post

The Government of Nunavut (GN) advises Nunavummiut to expect interruptions and delays in services typically provided by Canada Post. All Canada Post mail intake and delivery services have been suspended due to the ongoing strike action by the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW).

To minimize the strike action's impact on government programs and services, the GN has identified alternate means to transport and deliver materials between communities.

<u>Government Liaison Offices</u> in each community can assist in local distribution of government documents shipped to communities. Please note that you may be contacted by either your local air cargo service, or Government Liaison Officer to receive documents within your community.
