

Nunavut Liquor and Cannabis Enforcement and Inspections CONTRACT PART-TIME LIQUOR AND CANNABIS INSPECTORS Rankin Inlet

Liquor and cannabis inspectors are needed on a part-time contractual basis in Rankin Inlet to ensure licensed premises and special occasion permit holders comply with the provisions of the *Nunavut Liquor Act, Cannabis Act* and *Regulations*.

Experience in enforcement along with the ability to interpret acts and regulations would be considered an asset. You must have good written and oral communication skills. Most of the inspections occur on weekends and in the late evening. Additional inspections are done on an as-needed basis.

Successful candidates must submit a criminal record check and provide their own transportation. Training will be provided.

Priority will be given to Nunavut Inuit. Candidates must clearly identify their eligibility to receive priority consideration under the Nunavut Priority Hiring Policy.
