The Nunavut Food Security Coalition is now accepting funding proposals for projects that will address food insecurity in Nunavut in 2024-25.

Non-profit organizations, societies, businesses, and municipal organizations are invited to apply for funding in the following areas:

- 1. Food Security Projects:
 - Develop targeted support for those facing food insecurity.
 - Increase Nunavummiut's capacity for improving their own food security through the development of food skills and life skills.
 - Encourage joint learning of food skills and life skills by parents and children.
 - Reduce barriers to food access and help alleviate poverty.
- 2. Core Funding:
 - Contribute to alleviating poverty and reducing barriers to food access.
 - Support the core operations of food organizations, enhancing their ability to provide consistent services and programming throughout the year.
 - Work towards programming that goes beyond emergency food relief.
