The deadline for applications for the Assessment Appeal Tribunal (AAT) has been extended! The Department of Community and Government Services (CGS) is seeking interested individuals to serve on the AAT.

The AAT is a second level of appeal under the [Property Assessment and Taxation Act](#). The Tribunal has jurisdiction over all of Nunavut and adjudicates complaints from persons who wish to further appeal decisions of the Territorial Board of Revision (General Taxation Area) and the municipal Board of Revision (City of Iqaluit). Appointments last for three years and may be renewed.
