Call for applications: Territorial Board of Revision and Assessment Appeal Tribunal

The Department of Community and Government Services (CGS) is seeking interested individuals to serve on the Territorial Board of Revision and the Assessment Appeal Tribunal.

- The **Territorial Board of Revision** hears complaints in accordance with the [Property Assessment and Taxation Act](#) and has jurisdiction for the “General Taxation Area” (includes all of Nunavut outside the municipal boundaries of the City of Iqaluit). These complaints may be received from persons who wish to appeal their property *Notice of Assessment*, which informs the amount of property taxation. The Territorial Board of Revision has the power to review and revise property assessments. Appointments last for one year and may be renewed.
- The **Assessment Appeal Tribunal** is a second level of appeal under the [Property Assessment and Taxation Act](#). The Tribunal has jurisdiction over all of Nunavut and adjudicates complaints from persons who wish to further appeal decisions of the Territorial Board of Revision (General Taxation Area) and the municipal Board of Revision (City of Iqaluit). Appointments last for three years and may be renewed.

Interested individuals may submit their resume by email to CGSComms@gov.nu.ca. Please ensure your email clearly identifies the intention of your application with either the Territorial Board of Revision or the Assessment Appeal Tribunal.
