The Government of Nunavut (GN) is aware that Northwestel phone and internet customers in Nunavut may be experiencing disruptions due to wildfires in western Canada.

The GN is monitoring the situation, which may affect the ability of Nunavummiut to connect to emergency services.

If you need RCMP assistance and are unable to reach your local detachment by phone, you are directed to attend the detachment in person.

In Iqaluit, residents who are unable to reach the main emergency number at 867-979-4422 are asked to call 867-222-2954.
