Minister of Human Resources, David Akeeagok, and Minister of Family Services, Margaret Nakashuk, will distribute Long-Term Service Awards to Government of Nunavut (GN) public service employees in Arctic Bay, Resolute Bay, and Grise Fiord. The awards will be presented to eligible GN employees with five, 10, and 15 years of service for the period of 2020 to 2022.

The Long-Term Service Awards recognize eligible employees who serve continuously without an interruption to their record of employment. The recognition is provided in five-year increments of continuous service.

The upcoming community events are:

- Arctic Bay: May 6, 2024.
- Resolute Bay: May 8, 2024.
- Grise Fiord: May 9, 2024.

The event is part of a series of community visits across Nunavut. A gala will be held later this year to honour long-term employees with 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, and 45-plus years of continuous public service.
