## GN ends state of emergency in Kimmirut

**Kimmirut, Nunavut (November 8, 2024)** – Effective 12:00 a.m., November 9, 2024, the Minister of Community and Government Services (CGS) David Joanasie has ended the territorial state of emergency in Kimmirut.

"I am ending the territorial state of emergency in Kimmirut as the Qulliq Energy Corporation has fully restored power to the community, and all residents are safe," said Minister Joanasie. "I would like to thank the people of Kimmirut for their patience and acknowledge their resilience and efforts during this time. The care the community showed for one another was admirable."

While this emergency was managed at the local and territorial level, the willingness of our federal partners in Public Safety Canada and the Canadian Coast Guard to provide support, is acknowledged.

All Hamlet and Government of Nunavut services will resume normal operations on November 9, 2024. The state of emergency for Kimmirut was in effect from November 2 until November 8, 2024.
