Food recall due to possible Listeria monocytogenes contamination

October 22, 2024 Nunavut-wide

The Department of Health is warning about a food recall issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination.

Consumers should not consume the recalled products described below.

This recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the location where it was purchased.

Food contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes* may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Although *Listeria monocytogenes* is not commonly linked to human illness, in rare cases it can cause serious or fatal infections. *Listeria monocytogenes* can cause rare bloodstream and central nervous system infections and has been associated with severe intestinal infection (necrotizing enterocolitis) and blood poisoning (sepsis), especially in newborns.
