Winter is all about layers and the Department of Health is encouraging Nunavummiut to layer up and get vaccinated! Protect yourself, your family and your community from COVID-19 and the flu by getting vaccinated.

Starting today, Iqaluit Public Health (located at Building 1091 near the old airport terminal) will be holding a walk-in clinic offering COVID-19 and flu vaccines for all eligible Nunavummiut aged six months and older.

COVID-19 and flu vaccines provide crucial protection for you and your family during the colder months. Keeping your immunizations up to date is one of the best ways to protect yourself, your family, and the community from serious illness.

Weekday walk-in appointments will be available until November 8, 2024, during the following times:

- Monday to Friday from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m., and 1:00 to 4:30 p.m. at Iqaluit Public Health.

Weekend walk-in appointments will be available until November 9 during the following times:

- Saturdays from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. at Iqaluit Public Health.

After November 9, COVID-19 and flu vaccines will continue to be available for walk-ins every Friday from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m., and 1:00 to 4:30 p.m. at Iqaluit Public Health.
