New Certificate of Compliance form for municipal business licence applications

End Date: October 31, 2024

Nunavut-wide

The Department of Community and Government Services is advising municipal businesses that recent legislative changes now require all businesses applying for a municipal business licence in Nunavut to submit the new Certificate of Compliance form with their application every year.

Effective October 1, 2024, businesses are required to self-certify that they are in compliance with the [Workers' Compensation Act](#) in order to receive a municipal business licence. Submitting this form is a requirement under the [Cities, Towns and Villages Act](#) and the [Hamlets Act](#).

This change was made to improve the application process for both applicants and the Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission.
