Uqausirmut Quviasuutiqarniq has grown significantly since it was first launched as "Language Week" in 2000. It expanded to two weeks in 2015 and became a month-long celebration in 2016. Initially held in February (*Naliqqaittuq*), the event moved to April (*Nasairvik*) in 2023 and 2024, featuring themes centered on the *Qulliq* and *Nattiq*.

Uqausirmut Quviasuutiqarniq promotes the importance, history and diversity of Inuktitut in the territory. Nunavummiut are encouraged to celebrate Inuktitut every day through stories, games and by joining the conversation on social media using the hashtag #Quviasuutiqarniq.
