## Reminder to Nunavut francophone students: the Destination Clic summer program application deadline

The Department of Education is reminding Nunavut students in Grades 8, 9, and 10 whose first language is French, of the upcoming February 25, 2025 deadline to apply to *Destination Clic* Official Languages program.

Destination Clic is a summer program designed to help Nunavut francophone students develop their language skills, deepen cultural identity, and foster a sense of belonging to Canada's greater francophone community. Participants will engage in a variety of oncampus activities at universities across the country while also experiencing vibrant regional Francophone culture.

Accepted candidates will have the opportunity to enter a draw for a chance to win a bursary that may cover tuition fees and other related expenses. There are two additional bursaries for students from vulnerable groups and two bursaries for students residing in remote communities.

Destination Clic is an Official Languages program offered by the Council of Education Ministers, Canada, funded by the Government of Canada, and supported by the Government of Nunavut's Department of Education.
