EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY: Closure of Pond Inlet Caribou Harvest

Start Date: February 4, 2025 End Date: July 1, 2025

Pond Inlet 40 sec

The Baffin Island Caribou harvest for 2024-2025 in Pond Inlet is **closed effective immediately. No further harvesting is allowed.**

The Pond Inlet allocation of 46 caribou from the Total Allowable Harvest (TAH) for 2024-2025 from the Baffin Island Caribou population has been reached.

If you have harvested caribou prior to this closure notice, you are still responsible for reporting your harvest to the Wildlife Office.

Any additional harvesting of Baffin Island Caribou in Pond Inlet without allocation during the 2024-2025 season is in violation of the <u>Nunavut Wildlife Act</u>. Violations will be investigated and may lead to enforcement action.

The TAH was established by the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board to support the recovery of the Baffin Island Caribou population and is a critical piece in the comanagement efforts to allow the herd to recover and provide harvesting opportunities for future generations.
